Spider Woman & Trading Posts is a collaborative exhibition featuring works from the permanent collections of The Art Center of Western Colorado and Museums of Western Colorado, on view at Museum of the West from January 17 to March 21, 2026.

Exploring the evolution of Diné (Navajo) weaving—from its cultural origins with Spider Woman to the rise of regional trading-post styles—this exhibition highlights the beauty, innovation, and living traditions of Diné weavers.
